Introduction

Welcome to the Junior Eurovision Song Contest 2024, the 22nd edition of the competition that has run annually since 2003. Acts from seventeen nations will be taking to the stage in Madrid on Saturday, November 16th, for an incredible spectacle of music, culture, and language.

The theme for this year's event, "Let's Bloom", as well as the floral themes that will be visible throughout the program, highlights the blossoming creativity of these talented young performers, ranging in age from nine to fourteen. From impassioned pleas for peace and environmental justice to upbeat production numbers all about the joy of music and a touching ballad about one singer's own adoption journey, there will be something for everyone at La Caja Mágica this year.

Differences between Junior Eurovision and Eurovision

The Contest has been through many changes over the years. While there are similarities between the Eurovision Song Contest (ESC) and Junior Eurovision Song Contest (JESC), there are some very distinct differences too:

- Junior Eurovision host nations are selected via a bidding system, rather than automatically awarding hosting duties to the previous year's winner. While the winning nation does tend to get the "right of first refusal", this year's host nation, Spain, is hosting after last year's winning nation, France, declined to bid.
- The song must be sung in any of the country's national languages, although up to 40% of the lyrics are allowed to be in another language.
- Junior Eurovision's score is tabulated by a combination of national juries and an online public vote open to viewers from around the globe.

Participation

Active member broadcasters of the European Broadcasting Union are permitted to take part in the contest. However, the show has been screened in several non-participating countries, and contest participation may be extended to Associate Members on an invitation-only basis, as in the past cases of Australia and Kazakhstan.

Out of the forty-one countries that have participated at least once, only one country – The Netherlands – has competed in every Junior Eurovision so far. As of 2024, Georgia and France are the most successful nations at the Junior Eurovision Song Contest with three wins each. Armenia, Malta, and Poland have all won twice, and Belarus and Russia, which no longer participate in the Contest, also had two victories each during their years of participation.

2024 Host Venue: Caja Mágica, Madrid, Spain

Also known as the Manzanares Park Tennis Center, the Caja Mágica (Spanish for "Magic Box") is a multi-purpose sports facility known best as the home of the Madrid Open. It has a maximum capacity of over 12,000, plus a pair of other courts that can hold an additional 6,000 people. Opened in 2009, the venue has hosted the MTV Europe Music Awards in 2010, the Men's Handball World Championship in 2013, and the Davis Cup in 2019.

2024 Hosts

Ruth Lorenzo

Well known to Eurovision fans, Ruth is best known internationally as Spain's representative at Eurovision 2014, coming in 10th place with the powerful *Dancing in the Rain*. Since then, the Murcia native has released two full-length albums (with a third coming out imminently on her own label, Raspberry Records), has hosted *Benidorm Fest*, has dabbled in musical theatre, and has appeared on shows like Spain's editions of *Masterchef Celebrity* and *Your Face Sounds Familiar*. Notably, back in 2016, she earned herself a Guinness World Record for "The Most Live Concerts in Multiple Towns in Twelve Hours" when she performed concerts in eight different cities throughout Spain to raise funds for breast cancer research.

Marc Clotet

Barcelona-born actor and model Marc Clotet has been appearing on screens in Spain since his 2007 breakthrough on the Catalan soap opera *El cor de la ciutat (The Heart of the City)*. He's a stage and screen mainstay, performing in Spanish and Catalan. Earlier this year, he competed on Spain's edition of *Celebrity Bake-Off*, coming in a respectable eighth place, going up against Eurovision alumni Blas Cantó and both members of Azúcar Moreno!

Melani García

In what's becoming a recent tradition at Junior Eurovision, an alum of the contest will be on the panel of hosts this year. After winning *La Voz Kids* in 2018, Valencia-native Melani took home the bronze at Junior Eurovision 2019 with her operatic song *Marte*, thrilling audiences in Gliwice, Poland. Since then, she's been nominated for a Kids' Choice Award as Best Spanish Artist, performed at festivals worldwide, and has released several singles. Not bad for just seventeen years old!

 Tokionine was also part of the songwriting team for Srbuk's Walking Out in 2019.

- Cyprus
 - Crystal Waters was co-written by Sophia Patsalides, who performed for Cyprus at Junior Eurovision 2014. Her song, I pio omorfi mera, came in ninth place that year.
- Estonia
 - Sven Lõhmus, the sole songwriter listed on *Tänavad*, had previously written Estonian Eurovision entries *Let's Get Loud* (2005), *Rändajad* (2009), *Rockefeller Street* (2011), and *Verona* (2017), as well as at least fifteen entries for Estonian National Finals. This is his first foray into writing for Junior Eurovision.
- Georgia
 - Giorgi "Giga" Kukhianidze has been a mainstay at Junior Eurovision for Georgia since 2010's *Mari Dari*. Since then, he's also written *Funky Lemonade* (2012), *Give Me Your Smile* (2013), *Happy Day* (2014), *Gabede* (2015), *Voice of the Heart* (2017), *You Are Not Alone* (2020), *Let's Count the Smiles* (2021), and *I Believe* (2022), as well as *Echo* for Iru at Eurovision 2023.
- Italy
 - *Pigiama party* was co-written by Paolo Meneguzzi, who represented Switzerland at Eurovision 2008 with the song *Era stupendo*.
- North Macedonia
 - Siblings Magdalena Cvetkovska and Lazar Czetkoski had previously written *Fire* for Junior Eurovision 2019, as well as Eurovision entries *Pred Da Se Razdeni* (2013). Individually, Lazar was also part of the songwriting team for *To The Sky* (2014), *Proud* (2019), *and Fall From the Sky* (Albania 2020).
- San Marino
 - Come noi was written by the members of the band Miodio, who represented San Marino at the country's Eurovision debut in 2008 with the song *Complice*.
