How to run your Eurovision Sweepstakes

Note: Your sweepstakes should be completed prior to the first semi final – taking place on Tues 8th May.

1. Print out this document, cut out the countries from the first two pages, fold the strips and place them in a container such as a hat for a random draw
2. Have your entrants draw a country and collect your selected stake for each strip drawn. We recommend using 1 Euro/Pound/Dollar, etc as the amount
3. Note down the person who draws each country on the page 3 list
4. Place the final draw list in a public spot such as a noticeboard at your workplace
5. Following the contest, reward your winners with their prizes.

We advise the following prize amounts:

- 1st Place – 24 Euro/Pound/Dollars, etc
- 2nd Place – 12 Euro/Pound/Dollars, etc
- 3rd Place – 6 Euro/Pound/Dollars, etc
- Last Place (in the final) – Stake back

(If you want to make the stakes higher,
simply multiply the above by the amount of the stake).



Bright Idea!

Encourage your friends or workmates to embrace the contest even more by hosting the prize announcements over a morning tea or lunch. Share the cultures of the contestant countries by asking your entrants to bring a dish that represents the nation they have drawn.
